## PBA Country Club Lanes Central/Midwest Open Qualifying Sweeper #1

On May 12th, 2019 at Country Club Lanes, there were a total of 11 bowlers trying to get an entry for the seventh annual Central Midwest Open. The tournament format was a six game qualifying sweeper on the Mike Aulby 38 foot pattern. The winners that won the spot would be amateurs and PBA members. However it would only be PBA members that would receive the free entries. In game #1 Robert Moore would shoot the high game of 222. In the second game Robert Moore would shoot a game of 209 to have the high game. Games one through three Robert Moore would have the high game. In game three he would shoot 203. The Mike Aulby pattern would be demanding on tournament field as no one could score in the 200's. However by game four three bowlers would shoot in the 200's. This was the most the field could muster for the whole sweeper. Some bowlers were struggling to shoot a score over 120. It would take a score of minus 23 to win the tournament. Robert Moore struggled late in the block even having three games over 200. At one point he was thirty-five over after three and he would end up with 1171 to win the tournament. Robert Moore and Sam Ferrah, both non-PBA members, would be the bowlers that would receive the two spots earning them \$225 each.

## PBA Country Club Lanes Central/Midwest Open Qualifying Sweeper #2

On May 19th, 2019 there were 12 bowlers that were competing for a last chance for free entries into the PBA Country Club Central/Midwest Open. The lane pattern was the Mike Aulby 38 feet and scores were generally low. Tyler Wilds started it off with a game of 213 to lead the pack. He also lead game two with a score of 196. CJ Kirchner took the lead in game three with a score of 236 against Bill Crane who had a 226 and Tyler who had a 201. The competition between the top two heated up in game 4 when Tyler won with a 201 and kept the overall lead to only 14 pins. In game 5 CJ Kirchner struggled to shoot with a 173, his lower game of the sweeper. Tyler had an accurate game of 201 to lead the field and reclaim the lead by 17 pins. In the final game, Tyler really struggled with a 168 game, but CJ shot a 187 and was able to win the sweeper for the PBA Member entry. Scott Schmal had the high game in game 6 and was the winner for the non-PBA Member entry.

## PBA Country Club Lanes Central/Midwest Open Presented By 900 Global

There were a total of 55 bowlers competing at the Country Club Lanes Central/Midwest Open presented 900 Global. Defending Champion Devin Miller would lead the qualifying part with a score of +124 for seven games. His closest competitor was 71 pins by Mike Eaton, Jr. It would take a score of -2 to make the match play portion of the tournament. Brad Angelo would be the fourth place bowler to receive a one round bye. The top 4 qualifiers would be automatically seeded in the round of 8. While fifth through twelve would have to go through the duration of the tournament. In the round of 12, Tristan Butler of Fort Wayne, Indiana would go undefeated against David Harold, Jr. Averaging over 255.

The round of 8 saw Butler take on 2018 Harry Golden Rookie of the Year Kamron Doyle. He would also defeat him two games to zero. JR Raymond thought that he had lost his match in the round of 8, but Mike Eaton, Jr failed to mark in the tenth to take a two games to zero. Raymond would win the third and final game. Brad Angelo would tie his first game of match play and defeat his opponent after tying 234. Angelo would go on to win his match to the final four.

The final four Angelo would take on Greg Young. Angelo would stay clean and take out Greg 227-199. JR Raymond would handily defeat Tristan Butler of Fort Wayne, Indiana 201-155. Angelo struck out in the 9th and 10th frame to advance to the title match. Young needed to stay clean to advance to the championship match. However, he would open in the tenth frame giving Angelo the victory and advance to the championship to seek his third career PBA regional title.

In the Championship Match, Angelo started out strong by having a turkey. However he would leave a big four in the next two frames. Raymond could not jump on the opening that Angelo gave him. Raymond would really struggle in the championship match. He could not apply any pressure to Angelo's open frames back to back. The 2019 Country Club Lanes Central Mid West Open paid a total of \$9,750.00.

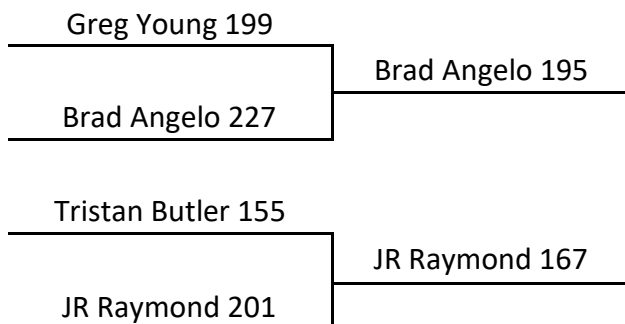

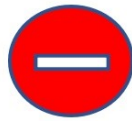
