PBA Central Region EZ Bowl Open

There were a total of 40 bowlers in the second annual EZ bowl open. Defending champion EJ Tackett could not successfully defend his title as he was trying to win the PBA FloBowling tournament in Texas. Ronnie Russell, Kurt Pilon, Brad Angelo, Graham Fach would be the top pros who would compete at this year's tournament. The pattern was on the Scorpion pattern. It would take a score of +90 by Charlie Brown Jr. and the leader was Justin Knowles, who had won the previously week in Sturgis, Michigan. He would be the qualifying leader with a score of +326. The tournament leader kept on leading the tournament as he would lead by almost 200 pins over second place. Zac Tackett would also qualify for the cut. Larry Verble would shoot the only 300. After the third game of qualifying, Justin Knowles just ran over the field and never looked back. There was some movement in the other position on the leader board as the scores were getting high for some bowlers and other bowlers could not strike. Ronnie Russell was looking to get into the stepladder finals, however he was unable to do accomplish this feat and missed the stepladder by twelve pins.

In the first match, Kurt Pilon would take on Richard McCormick. Early in the match it looked like the scores were going to be high. However McCormick had a few open frames in a row and could never recover as Pilon kept on striking. Pilon would defeat McCormick 234 to 189. In the semi-finals, Pilon started with a turkey, however he open in the fourth frame. This was an unusual spare shot for a pro as he would only get three on his first ball. Even though Joe Bailey opened in the first frame, he came back strong with a 7 bagger. Pilon could not keep up with Bailey who would defeat him 245 to 198. The championship match saw Justin Knowles strike as he was doing that throughout the entire tournament. This was Justin's second consecutive PBA Regional title. He would defeat Joe Bailey 248 to 174.
