## 7th Annual MSBS Pro bowl West Open

The 2019 MSBS Pro bowl had 37 bowlers competing at this years tournament. The scores were higher as it would take a score of +78 to advance to the match play round. Bowlers would bowl 6 games of qualifying, the pattern was the Kegel Navigation boardwalk V2 across 12 lanes with the top ten advancing to match play. Some of the high games were: Chandler Stevens shot a 279 in game 3. Another high score would be 289 by eventual winner Mathew Staninger. Jeremy Delcamp had not been bowling for a couple years and still had a 278 game. It would take a score of +78 by Craig Nidiffer to make the cut. Aaron Beaver was the high qualifier with a score of +202 for his sixth game. Mike Cowell would be the highest non cashing senior with a score of +25: he collected \$100 for his efforts. Some others that made the cut were: Chandler Stevens, Mikey Schlabach, and Craig Nidiffer.

In the match play portion there would be some upsets: Aaron Beaver was beat by Craig Nidiffer with 509 to 416., Jeremy Delcamp not only made the cut but won his first match over Chandler Stevens the newest Regional PBA champion at Pro Bowl West. Delcamp who had not been bowling in a while would wipe out Stevens 415 to 352. Bill Essman Sr. would shoot a 457, while Matt Staninger shot 491 to win, consequently; this was the highest match.

The stepladder finals would be Craig Nidiffer take on Jeremy Delcamp in the opening match. Delcamp would struggle by shooting a 162, Nidiffer was striking and shot a 234. This would allow Nidiffer to face off Mikey Schlabach in the second match. Mikey Schlabach and Craig Nidiffer would have a high scoring match. Schlabach was somewhat closer then Delcamp was in match one: however, he came up a little bit short as he could only muster up a 214 but a loss to Nidiffer's 246. It looked like Dakota Neff was going to have his hands full with Nidiffer but Nidiffer would struggle to hit 200, the final score was 236 to 200. The championship match saw Dakota Neff as he only bowled a 156 game to Mathew Staninger winning 234 game. This was Staninger's third career MSBS title.

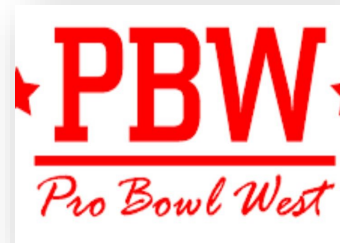
