MISCELLANEOUS.:

Is making his first telecast of this season... Since making the first TV appearance of his career in 1991, has now made at least one TV appearance per season for 20 consecutive seasons... Made one telecast in each of the last two seasons (finishing third both times), but has not won since capturing the Dexter Tournament of Champions on April 9, 2005 (his lone "major" title)... Owns seven career Lumber Liquidators PBA Tour titles and one Major title... In 1999 in Chattanooga, TN, Jaros became just the 13th player in PBA history to roll a televised 300 game (he defeated Ricky Ward, 300-200) on his way to winning his third PBA title... Jaros is an avid bowler in the PBA's regional program and has 42 regional titles to his credit... Jaros' first two career titles both came in Edmond, OK, in 1991 and 1993... His three titles in 2003-04 matched his career total entering that season and he also earned a career best \$166,300 that season... In addition to his 2005 T of C win, he also finished second in that event the following year, losing to Chris Barnes... Ranks 12th on the PBA's Career Earnings list with more than \$1.68 million.

Has made three telecasts this season...He finished fourth last week at the Mark Roth Plastic Ball Championship in Cheektowaga, NY...Was the tournament leader at the PBA Tournament of Champions, but finished second to Mika Koivuniemi...He also finished fourth in this season's GEICO Shark Championship...Made three telecasts last season...His first career TV appearance came last season in the Scorpion Championship at the World Series of Bowling in Allen Park, MI, where he finished third...In just his second career TV appearance, he won the PBA World Championship in Wichita, KS, defeating reigning PBA Player of the Year Wes Malott, 244-228...His third TV appearance of the season came with partner Jodi Woessner in the Mixed Doubles event in Wheat Ridge, CO, where they finished fifth...Last season was his first as an exempt player after having earned his exemption by finishing third in the 2009 PBA Tour Trials held at Thunderbowl in Allen Park, MI...Smallwood bowled on Tour as a non-exempt player in 2003-04 (bowling in the TQRs)...He bowled 18 events with a best finish of seventh in Dallas, TX (his best career finish prior to last season)...Only decided to bowl in the PBA Tour Trials because he had been laid off from his job at General Motors...Owns two PBA regional titles.

MISCELLANEOUS

Was voted the 26th Greatest PBA Player... Won this season's PBA World Championship for his first win since the 2008-09 season... The win made him the sixth player in PBA history to complete bowling's Triple Crown (Tournament of Champions, U.S. Open, World Championship)... Captured his first career Major title in the 62nd U.S. Open in 2005 and won the 2006 Tournament of Champions for his second career Major title... Had three second-place and one fourth-place finish last season, but went winless in a season for the first time since the 2000 season... Made eight telecasts in 2008-09 & won two titles... Won 2007-08 PBA Player of the Year honors after making nine shows and winning two titles... Joined Mike Aulby and Tommy Jones as the only players to win both the PBA Rookie and Player of the Year awards in their career (Rookie of Year in 1998)... Graduated from Wichita State where he was an All-American in 1990 and '92 and Collegiate Bowler of the Year in 1992... Has been a member of Team USA nine times, including the 2008 "Dream Team" and the 2011 team... Made 12 telecasts in 2000 without a title, the PBA record for most TV appearances in one year without a win... In his first eight seasons on Tour, amassed \$1,244,315 in earnings, becoming the fastest player (200 events) to earn \$1 million... Is 8th all-time in PBA career earnings (more than \$1.92 million).

MISCELLANEOUS

Was the tournament leader for this season's Bayer USBC Masters in Reno, NV, but lost the title match to Tom Hess, 225-214... Won his second career title last season when he defeated Mike Fagan in a roll-off, 10-8, to win the Shark Championship in Allen Park, MI... That win was his second career title and first since March 25, 1995 -- a span of 14 years, 175 days that encompassed 164 events bowled... The time between titles set a PBA record for longest period between wins... Finished last season in the Top 20 in average (20th), earnings (13th) and points (12th)... Made one telecast in 2008-09, finishing fourth in the Cheetah Championship in his hometown of Cheektowaga (Buffalo), NY... Won his first Tour title in the 1995 Tums Classic in Windsor Locks, CT, defeating David Traber, 231-228, in the title match... Recently changed his name from Ritchie to Dick Allen, citing the recent birth of his first child (March 3) Piper Bailey Allen (initials P.B.A.) as the reason he needed a first name that was more of a "dad" name...Has made one telecast this season, finishing third in the season-opening Brunswick Pro Bowling Cheetah Championship...That was his first TV appearance since March 29, 2009 (2008-09 season)...His last title came in Jan. of 2006 when he defeated Del Ballard Jr. to win in Phoenix, AZ...Owns two career Lumber Liquidators PBA Tour titles... Won his first career title by going 2-0 in the finals of the 2002 Dallas Open; knocked off Rick Steelsmith in the title match, 245-237... The win made him the 74th bowler in Tour history to win a title in their first career television appearance...Had a tough road to earning an exemption, coming up just shy three times...He finished 53rd in the 2003-04 PBA World Point Rankings, missing an exemption by four spots...Finished one spot shy of an exemption in the 2004 PBA Tour Trials...Then finished second in the 2004-05 PBA South Region, finishing just 1,820 points behind Randy Weiss to miss by one spot...Finally earned his way back on Tour with a ninth-place finish in the 2005 PBA Tour Trials, firing a 259 in the 45th and final game of the week... Kept his exemption by winning his second career title in 2005-06... Cousin Jeremy Mayfield is a NASCAR driver... Has a number of tattoos, including one on the back of his neck that says "Next"; he says it keeps him motivated, and that someday he'll be "next"... Also has a Dr. Suess Cat in the Hat tattoo, as well as a tribal symbol on his arm and a tattoo on his forearm that says "THB" for "Typical House Bowler" which is his nickname.
