

Page Maintains Lead after Five Rounds

Rhino Page still leads the way, by 137 pins over Jason Belmonte. Belmo rolled a perfect game to help keep pace with his left-handed rival. There are a number of bowlers that have a legitimate shot at the top five. There are three lefties in the top five: Page, Patrick Allen and Scott Norton. Page is looking for revenge from the 2009 ToC, when he knocked down only four pins on his second ball in the tenth frame (losing to PA, 267-264). Scores are awfully high, as it has taken 240 average to stay in the top five. So far, there have been 20 perfectos, two of them by England's Dom Barrett in the first round of match play alone. After dropping to 18th, Liz Johnson fought her way back to 12th, 221 pins behind fifth-place Bill O'Neill. Page has won 11 of his 18 match play game (while tying one game).
