

Overview and Tournament Format

The RPIs are set. Each RPI allows the top 48 to advance to the Regional Players Invitational. The top 15 in each region in the points will get a free entry in the RPI. Sixteen thru fortyeight will have to pay a \$220 entry fee. These RPIs are a 1.2 cashing ratio. Each RPI tournament will have two 6 game blocks. The top 4 qualifiers will receive a two round buy, while 5th thru 8th will receive a one round by. The bottom eight will go into a single elimination match play bracket. The winners of those matches will join 5th thru 8th in another best of 5 match. Then the winners of those matches will join the top 4 qualifiers in another best of 5 match. The winners will go into a round of 4 where it will be a single game format until there is a champion determined. Each winner of the RPIs will receive \$6,000 in cash and a free entry into the 5th World Series of Bowling. The 6 winners of the RPIs will have a chance to win a spot into the 2014 Tournament of Champions. There will be 2 matches of 3 players with the high scorer of each match advancing to the championship game. The winner of the championship game will receive the entry to the 2014 Tournament of Champions. For more information on who got a free entry in each Regional Players Invitational, log on to pba.com.
