





MessengerPBA Playoffs

In the first round of the 2020 edition of the PBA Playoffs there were some surprises. After Rash won the 2020 Cheetah Championship at the WSOB. Francis Lavoie would become the second bowler to bowl a second game twice on national television. In the round of 24 François would defeat two-time Player of the Year & Hall of Famer Norm Duke 256-193. All of the PBA Hall of Famers were eliminated early in this year's PBA Playoffs. Tommy Jones would be defeated by Jakob Butturff 215 to 214. Marshall Kent defeated his opponent Chris Via 218-212. Nick Pate defeated Darren Tang 207-202. Belmonte might lose the Player of the Year race if Kyle Troup wins the PBA Playoffs it will give him four titles of the year. However Belmonte became the second player to successfully complete the SuperSlam when he won the U.S. Open and then he would go on to win his third PBA World Championship. It would be a great championship matchup if Belmonte and Troup were to meet in the championship match. The defending champion and the 2020 Tournament of Champions winner Kris Prather would defeat Marshall Kent 237-214 in hopes of defending his title.

Hello Bowling fans thank you for another great season of the Josh Hyde Bowling Newsletter. As of September 2019 the publication of the newsletter took a hiatus until January of 2020 in order to complete the Bowlology book and Silver USBC Coaching.

Receiving the Silver Coach Award from the USBC was one of highlights of my bowling career. The Bowlology book was an eight year endeavor. The Bowlology column started in November of 2011. The first column was about the Perfect Strike. These were the projects that I was working extensively on. By having a column called Bowlology it allowed me to obtain both my Bronze and Silver Coaching. Earlier this year when Jason Belmonte became the second bowler to win every major that was quite an event. He had to make the 3-6-9-10. He joined Mike Aulby as the only two bowlers to win all five majors. Belmonte would win his third PBA World Championship a couple of weeks later. Tommy Jones became the third bowler to bowl a 300 in the championship game. He would also join Mike Durbin in winning the tournament when he got inducted into the PBA Hall of Fame. I also was able to bowl two 800's in a month of each other. My first 800 was an 816 with two 279's and a 258. My second 800 was an 837 with three 279's. Parker Bohn III gave me one of his 300 rings for me shooting a 300. Thank you Parker Bohn III. Last month I had two 700's with a 289 game. To the subscribers of this newsletter I cannot thank you guys enough for your support and interest in it after 12 years.




