Tournament Recap

Tackett wins 4th consecutive PBA World Championship

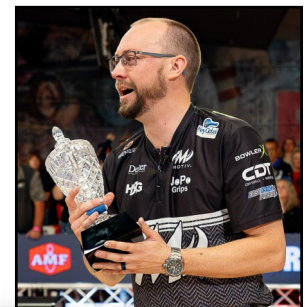
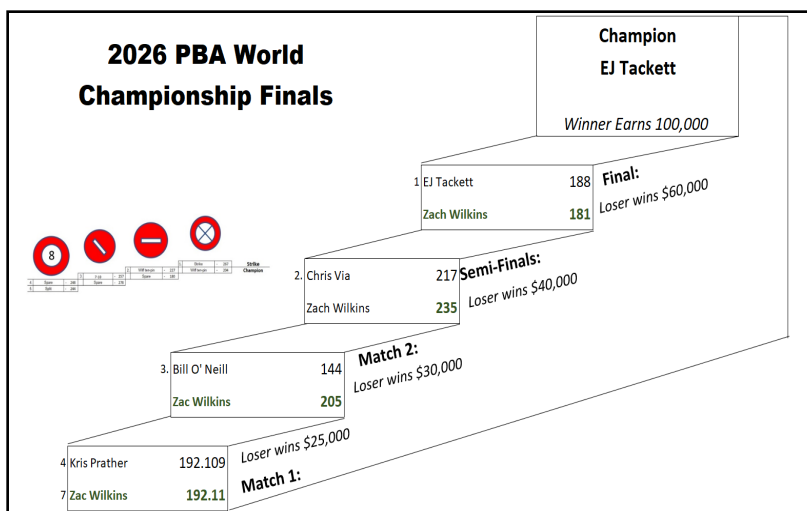
Reigning Chris Schenkel PBA Player of the Year, EJ Tackett, became the first bowler ever to win four consecutive PBA World Championship titles. This was EJ's 28th career title and 8th career Major title. Tackett would defeat Zac Wilkins 188 to 181 in the Championship match. Wilkins would only need to mark in the tenth but left a 4-9 split. Wilkins came up a little bit short giving EJ the history making title.

"I can't even put it into words what this feels like right now, to do something that no one else has ever done in the history of our sport," he stated with a tear in his eye.

The 2026 PBA World Championship did not produce high scores as in times past. The championship rounds featured nine bowlers and two televised finals. The first show would be on the CBS Sports Network, while the next show would be featured on CBS. Both CBS shows were conducted on the Earl Anthony pattern.

On the first show of the day, the first match saw Jason Sterner taking on Darren Tang. Tang would need a strike on the final ball to tie the game but would fail leaving a 10-pin. Sterner would go on to win 203 to 202. Jason then would meet Zac Wilkins. He would only muster up a 165 against Zac Wilkins 180. The next two matches would be all Wilkins: Zac's 185 to Jason Belmonte's (15 time Major Champion) 181, and then Zac's 223 to Brandon Bonta's 173. Overall players were having a hard time hitting the pocket, going brooklyn a number of times.

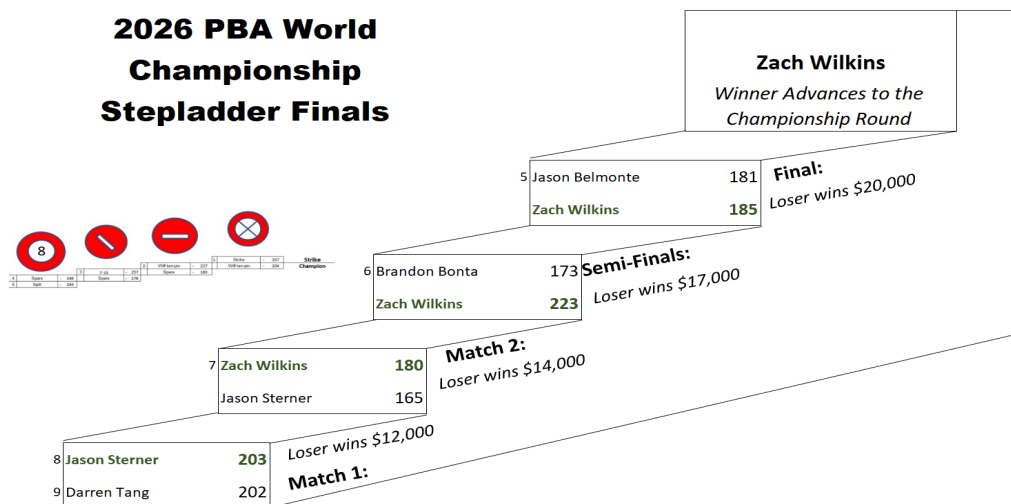
In the first game, Kris Prather and Zak Wilkins would tie the game at 192. Both players would strike on the first ball in sudden death. On the next ball, Prather would leave a nine pin while Wilkins struck to win the game. PBA Hall of Famer, Bill O' Neill, started the second game out with a double but only mustered a 144 against Zac's 205. In the semi-finals, Zac scored 235 to beat 217, Chris Via, in the highest scoring match. Wilkins, shooting for his first Major and his seventh match win of the day, was unable to seal the deal, leaving EJ with a unprecedented win.

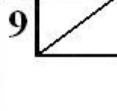

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Warren Wins the 2026 USBC Senior Masters

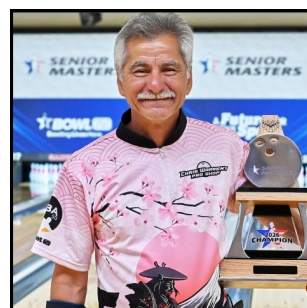
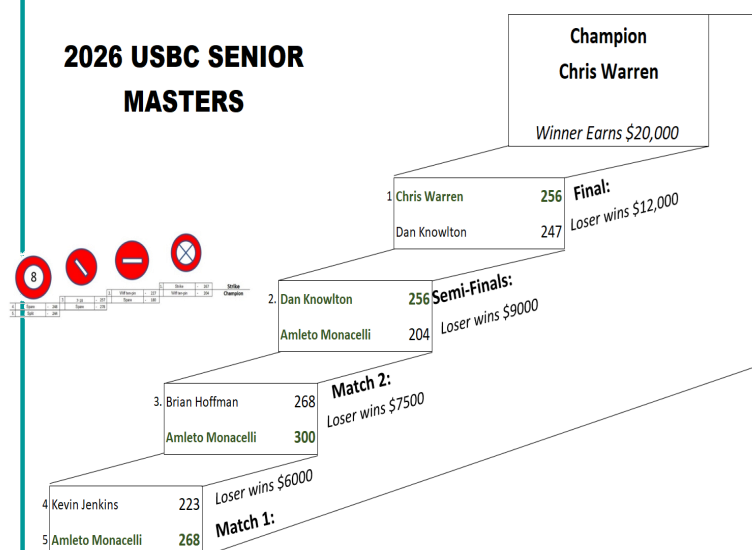
Tournament Recap

Chris Warren became the 8th player in USBC Senior Masters to win multiple Senior Master titles by defeating Dan Knowlton 256 to 247. Warren would double in the tenth to claim the title. Warren would start off slow by missing a ten pin in the first frame but then he would catch fire by throwing an 8 bagger.

"Lucky, fortunate, blessed, how else would you want to put it? Maybe it was fate or karma," Warren said. "Things just happen, and there's no rhyme or reason for it. Things could have gone so many different ways, but I guess it was just my time."

In the opening match of the 2026 USBC Masters, PBA Hall of Famer Amleto Monacelli took on Kevin Jenkins. Both players started off striking but Amleto kept on striking hoping to become the first player to win three USBC Senior Masters. Monacelli would defeat Kevin Jenkins 268 to 223. The second match saw Monacelli take on Brian Hoffman. This was a high scoring match as both players started out with a front 7. However, Hoffman went nine spare in the eighth and ninth frame. Monacelli would keep on striking in shooting a 300 game over Hoffman's 268. In the semi-final game, Amleto would have a hard time as the lanes were transitioning while Dan Knowlton found a line and struck. Knowlton would win the game quite easily 256 to 204.

The 2026 USBC Senior Masters saw a number of high scores as the tournament produced twenty 300 games. There would be a total of three bowlers who would bowl multiple 300 games at the USBC Senior Masters. Anthony Crews would throw three perfect games. Crews would also score the biggest block in USBC Senior Masters history with a score of 1410 during the second round of qualifying. Michael Machuga would be the leading qualifier + 742. This would be a record for the qualifying leader. There were three 800's shot during the matchplay of the tournament. Scores were exceptionally high as the cut took a score of +357 by Kevin Jenkins. The last cash spot went to Gordon Kaufman, Ron Mohr, Jim Pratt, Michael Calvin who all shot a score of +337. Mike McHugh would be the lowest super senior with a score of + 311 to not cash in the USBC Senior Masters.

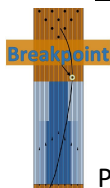

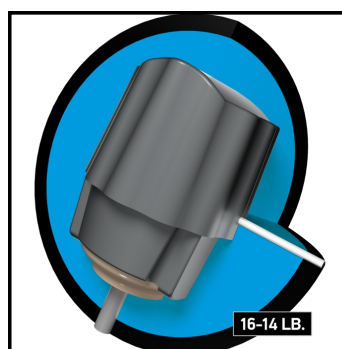

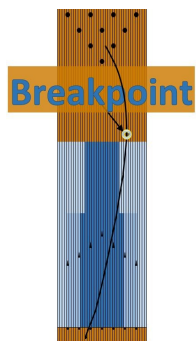

Breakpoint: 43rd person to score a 900

On June 18th, 2026 the forty-third person to shot a 900 was Dylan Maycon at South Plains Lanes in Lubbock, Texas. Dylan achieved the 44th 900 on the USBC Certified 900 list during his Thursday Doubles Leagues.

"It still doesn't feel like it happened," Macon said. "I'm just happy for myself and happy for all the support I've had for the last 16, 17 years I've been bowling, to be able to do it and bring it home to the center I've spent most of my work life at."

Macon's previous bowling achievements have been winning an Eagle at the USBC Open Championships and winning a PBA Regional Title. Dylan is the second bowler to win an Eagle and to bowl a 900 certified series. Jeremy Sonnenfeld was the first, rolling the first officially sanctioned 900 in 1997 (Glenn Allison was the actual first) and winning an Eagle four years later.
